



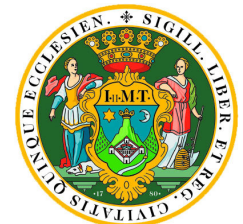

WHAT THE PROJECT IS ABOUT?

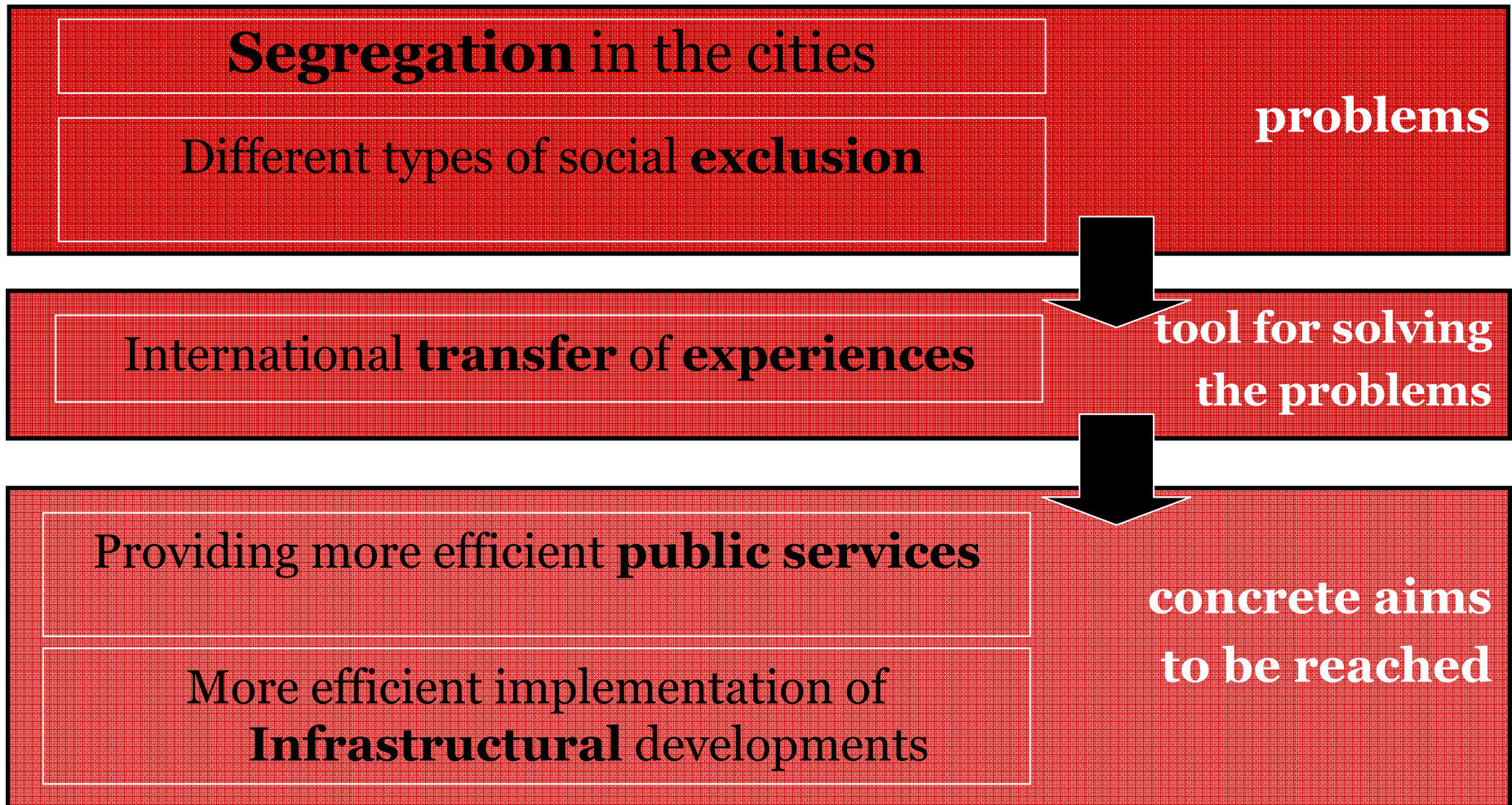

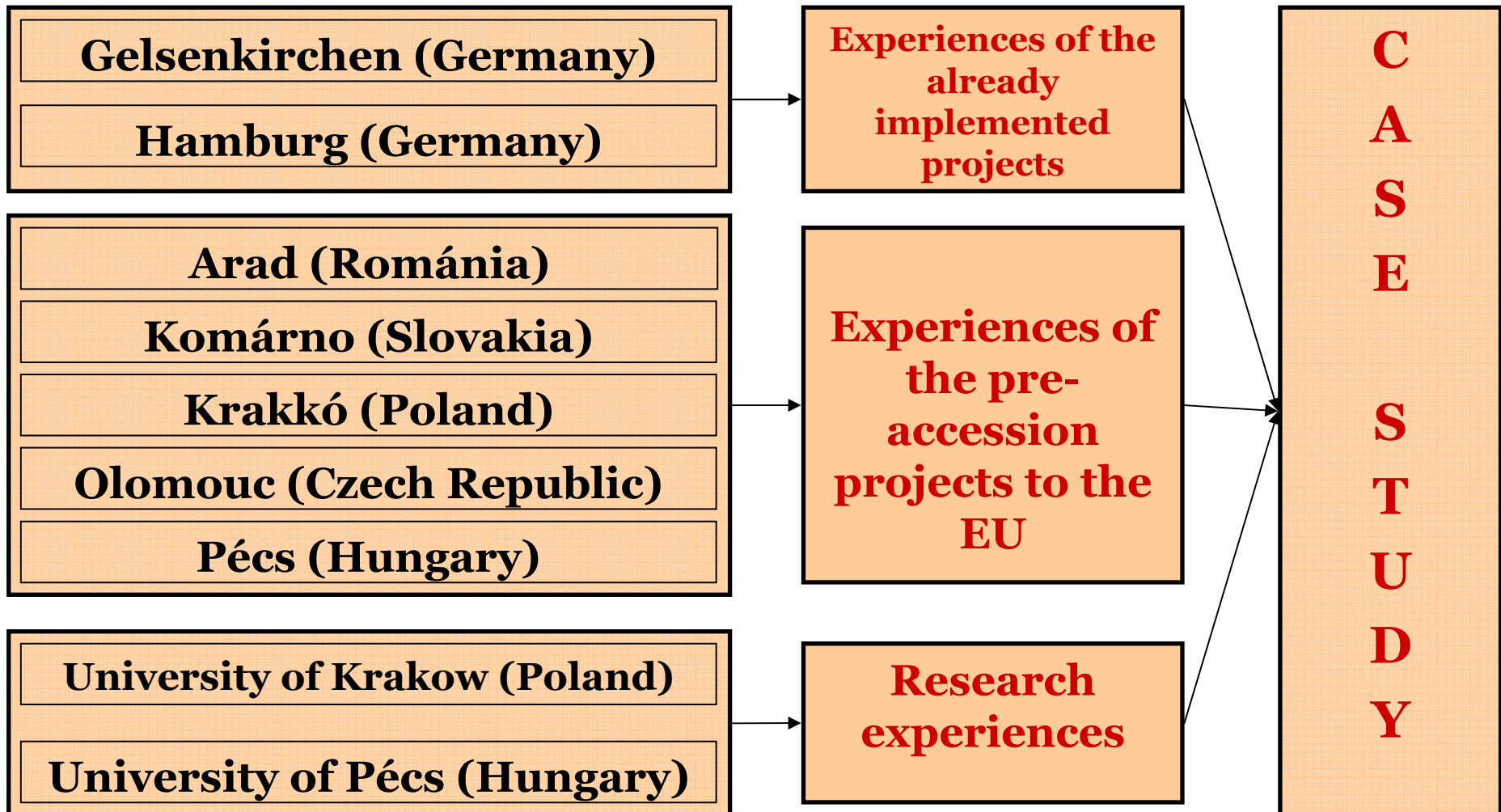

Main professional elements of CASE project
(activities/results by components)

1. Component

- Assessing a printed and electronic data base of all partners considering their existing CASE related activities, policies, researches, investigations;
- Preparation of CASE Newsletter – for each implementation period (6 monthly);
- Coordinating the preparation of the final output of urban rehabilitation model strategy;
- Organising the final publication of the project – CASE Study;
- Organising and participating in the professional conferences, workshops.

2. Component

- Preparation of a comparative analysis on the situation in the partner cities: levels, forms, reasons and existing solutions of segregation problems;
- Analysing the best practices of Hamburg regarding the handling of problems of segregation;
- Preparation of a thematic analysis on the context and level of segregation and anti-segregation policy in the cities;
- Online and printed preparation of the best already existing anti-practices handbook (on the level of public administration, municipal anti-segregation and on the level of the decision makers);
- Preparartion of the „Compley Anti Segregation Decision Making Strategy”;
- Participating in conferences and workshops, organising study-trips and participating in them.

3. Component

- Development of the concept for Urban Rehabilitation training programs
- Preparation of research schemes: (infrastructural and social research schemes as well as on social capital);
- The assessment of the present situation of segregation in the partner cities;
- 1-1 data base (infrastructural and social) kialakítása és hozzáférhetővé tétele a Partnerek számára;
- Preparation and introduction of the final research report;
- Completion of the design of the urban rehabilitation training programs;
- Publication of all results and the data bases on the common CD-ROM;
- Publication of the studies in the conference volume in English language;

4. Component

- Assessment of the social services available in the partner cities (child-care, education, medical, public administration services);
- Preparation of a study on the existing methods of the partners in the field of municipality initiated civil service capacity and community development;
- Elaboration of the concept of network oriented consultancy for residents affected by social exclusion/segregation;
- Preparation of the Subjective Social Map (interviewing and analysing the answers of 500 clients in a public opinion poll 125-125 questionnaires in each CEE cities);
- Preparation of the international best-practices on the opportunities and tasks of the municipalities for civil community development in CASE cities;
- Preparation of the final documents on social service development strategies in order to avoid segregation, social exclusion (summary of the studies prepared in the framework of the component);
- Participating in conferences and organising workshops.
