Number of trans-national partners required	<p>The projects will be implemented by partnerships that will always involve partners from both EU Member States and non-EU partner countries. The participation of Turkish partners is only possible in tripartite projects involving at least one partner from a Member State and one partner from Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, R. Moldova, Ukraine or Russia.</p> <p>The recommended number of partners involved in each project partnership is between 3 and 10 partners.</p>
Maximum percentage financed by the Commission	<p>90%</p> <p>Each participating country shall decide on its own co-financing system (from national or regional/local level or directly from the Beneficiary). Co-financing is to be provided by the Beneficiaries in order to demonstrate local commitment. No resources, which have been assisted by other EC contribution, may be taken into account as own contribution.</p> <p>Furthermore, proposals financed by other EU sources can not be submitted. Contribution in kind is not allowed. Cost of staff assigned to the Action is not a contribution in kind and may be considered as co-financing in the Budget of the Action when paid by the Beneficiary or its partners.</p>
Maximum grant	<p>Priorities 1 & 2 : €700.000</p> <p>Priority 3: €250.000</p>
