This Master Class programme arises from the project EUREGIO III which has received funding from the European Union, in the framework of the Public Health Programme.

EUREGIO III supports the innovative approach of using Structural Funds for health. The general objective of the project is to identify & share good practice and lessons learned for the **effective use of structural funds** for health & help reduce health inequalities among EU regions. It is a key resource to help Member States, regional & local authorities and actors to develop, apply & implement Structural Funds projects for health gain.
